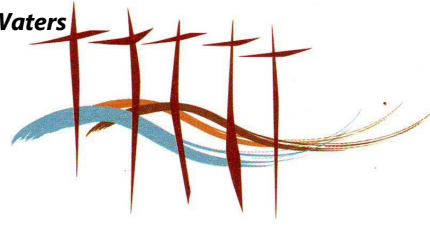

## The Most Holy Trinity 27 May, 2018

Year B: Deut 4:32-34,39-40; Rom 8:14-17; Mt 28:16-20

next week's Readings: Ex 24:3-8; Heb 9:11-15; Mk 14:12-16,22-26

### Triune God

Dear brothers and sisters,

Today is Trinity Sunday. It is one of the basic truth of our Catholic faith, that is the One God they're Three Divine Persons, distinct but equal, we invoke based on the Gospel as the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The doctrine of the Trinity explains to us in a very elemental way what God has revealed to us about himself so far. And he did this gradually and progressively according to our capacity and need. The Old Testament is explicitly monotheistic and the New Testament is also monotheistic but it is also explicitly Trinitarian. All three persons of the Trinity are found in five of the key scenes in the Gospel: 'the Annunciation, the Baptism of Jesus, the Last Supper, Calvary, and the Ascension.' It is true that creation is attributed to the Father, redemption to the Son and sanctification to the Holy Spirit. But the fact and the truth of the matter is that the Trinity was the efficient cause of 'all extra activities'. At present, without the Trinity we cannot understand Christianity. What would Christmas, Easter and Pentecost mean if there was no Trinity?

The Three Divine Persons are distinct. It is because Jesus Christ who became man is not God the Father nor He is the Holy Spirit. God the Father is not Jesus Christ or the Holy Spirit. God the Holy Spirit is not the God the Father or Jesus Christ. They are really distinct from each other. Our proof for this was when Jesus was Baptized in the Jordan River. God the Father in a loud voice was there, God the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove was there and God the Son who was baptized was there too. The Eleventh Council of Toledo (AD 675) also said: "He is not the Father who is the Son, nor the Son he who is the Father, nor is the Holy Spirit he who is the Father or the Son". But the full meaning of this concept is far beyond our poor comprehension.

The revelation of the Trinity is one of the greatest proofs of God's love for us. We do not reveal ourselves to those we do not love. We reveal ourselves in proportion to our love. In revealing the Trinity God revealed his very nature, his most intimate life. Church believes it, practices it and teaches to practice it. Church starts and ends its prayers, blessings and gives all sacraments in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
