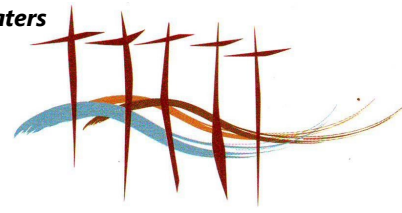

You are God's temple

Dear brothers and sisters,

Today's Gospel brings us a particular incident in the life of Jesus by which it was Jesus driving the people or the sellers and moneychangers out of the temple. He was angry because they made His father's house like a market place. There are question that confront us today. Have we ever "turned our Father's house or the church in to a market place?"



We have turned it in to a market place if we make it a cozy social club instead of Catholic action. On the other hand, have we ever driven the Lord out of the temple of our hearts? We have driven Him if we harbour grudges against someone, hate someone, judge them harshly, or ignore their cry for help. The heart of every Christian is a temple of God. The Blessed Trinity dwells in its inmost depth. God desires to receive prayerful homage and loving worship from the heart of each one of us whom He created and loves so intensely. Yet how often that our hearts are clogged by evil habits and sins or cluttered up with all kinds of unworthy desires and worldly projects that are pagan rather than Christian. There is oppression of the poor, dishonesty in business, greed of gain, shady dealing with the unscrupulous, cold treatment of neighbours and relatives. The heart of man needs cleansing, a healing and a renovation. It needs to be transformed in to the image of God as it is destined to be.

Our parish church is a house of God because in it is the tabernacle where the Body and Blood of Christ are being kept under the appearance of the sacred host and wine. As the same time, St. Paul in his letter to the Corinthians said: "Surely you know that you are God's temple and God's Spirit lives in you! So if anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy him. For God's temple is holy, and you yourselves are his temple". (1Cor 3:16-17).

World Labyrinth Day is a movement which encourages people from around the world to reflectively walk a labyrinth on the same day for world peace. Usually held on the first Saturday in May, the theme is *Walk as One @ 1*. That is, all walk together at 1pm in their local time. Because the weekend of 5/6 May is a busy one for Burleigh Heads Parish in celebrating the 50th Anniversary of the Marymount Schools, **the parish is hosting facilitated labyrinth walks in Mercy Church, 3 Sunlight Drive, Burleigh Waters on Sunday 29th April**. Please join us **after the 10am Mass** or **after the 5.30pm Mass** for facilitated labyrinths walks, as together we pray for peace in our troubled world. The first walk will commence soon after the 10am Mass finishes, around 11.15am. The second walk will commence around 6.30pm, soon after the 5.30pm Mass finishes. The Sunday night walk will be a candle lit walk.

Information about the labyrinth. The labyrinth is not a maze wherein one 'gets lost' and needs to figure out the path. The path of the labyrinth is fully viewed. There is one path in to the centre, and the same path leads out from the centre. There are remnants of labyrinths around the world, some dating back to 5,000 years or more. One of the most famous labyrinths is in Chartres Cathedral, France, which continues being walked today. The Founder of Veriditas, the Reverend Dr. Lauren Artress, defines the labyrinth as *"a spiritual tool that has many applications in various settings. It reduces stress, quiets the mind and opens the heart. It is a walking meditation, a path of prayer, and a blue-print where psyche meets Spirit."*

So please join the Burleigh Heads Parish community on Sunday 29th April 2018 as we walk together for world peace.

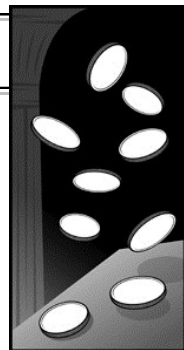

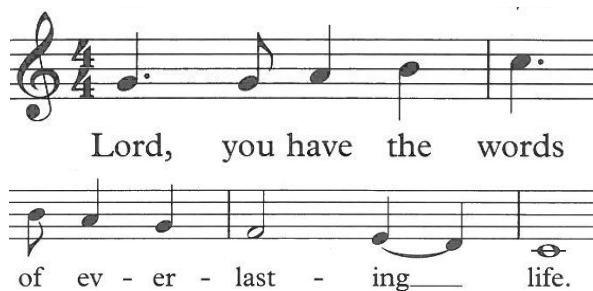
